Illness Policy

In the event that **Glen Hodgetts** falls ill and is unable to continue to act on your behalf the following policy will apply:-

1. The client will be informed by email and/or telephone of the incapacity of Glen Hodgetts at the earliest opportunity to allow you the maximum amount of time to instruct alternative counsel.

2. A notice to this effect will be posted on the website of Glen Hodgetts and will also be stated on his voicemail if you are unable to contact him directly.

3. Glen Hodgetts will make all reasonable attempts to refer you to a Barrister who is able and willing to take instructions from you.

4. Glen Hodgetts will, if able, provide you with a letter that you will be able to present to a Court or Tribunal, confirming the date on which you were informed that he would be no longer able to act on your behalf due to illness. You may need this to present to a Court or Tribunal if you wish to apply for your case to be adjourned if you have been unable to secure alternative representation in the time available.
